Visa requirements

Attendees are advised to check with the British Consulate in their home country regarding visa requirements before departing to the United Kingdom. Please take into account that the delivery of the visa may take several weeks, so it is important that you start the paperwork as soon as possible.

EU/EEA and Swiss nationals (and seven additional nationals <u>listed here</u>) can simply travel to the UK and enter as a Standard Visitor via the electronic gates, i.e. there is no visa application process. Other nationals (<u>visa nationals</u>) will need to apply for the Standard Visitor visa in advance of travel. King's will provide a sponsor letter for anyone who requires a Standard Visitor visa. More information on obtaining a sponsor letter is included in the registration form.

Medical insurance

All attendees are required to have medical insurance coverage to cover any illness or accident that may occur during their stay in the United Kingdom. The insurance must cover the entire period of the person's intended stay or transit.

If you are coming to the UK on a visa that is for less than six months and you did not pay the Immigration Health Surcharge you will not be able to use the National Health Service for free.
